HOW TO REACH MILAN

The city of Milan is reachable by public transport or by car

BY TRAIN

Railway line Tirano - Milano

Departure station: COLICO (Lc) – Arrival station: Milan Central Station (Mi)

Duration: about 85 minutes – Price (one way ticket): € 7.30

From Milan Central Station take the Metro Yellow Line 3 (S. Donato direction) and get off at “Duomo” stop (€ 1.50)

How to reach Colico: Bus, Line C10 Como – Colico (€ 2.50)/ Hydrofoil (€ 5.70)/ Car

Railway line Chiasso – Como - Milano

Departure station: Como S. Giovanni –Arrival station: Milano Porta Garibaldi

Duration: about 60 minutes – Price (one way ticket): € 4.80

From Milan P. Garibaldi station take the Metro Green Line 2 (Assago or Abbiategrasso direction) and get off at “Cadorna” stop. Here take the Metro Red Line 1 (Sesto 1° Maggio FS direction) and get off at “Duomo” stop (€ 1.50)

How to reach Como: Bus, Line C10 Colico – Como (€ 5.60)/ Hydrofoil (€ 17.50)/ Car

BY CAR

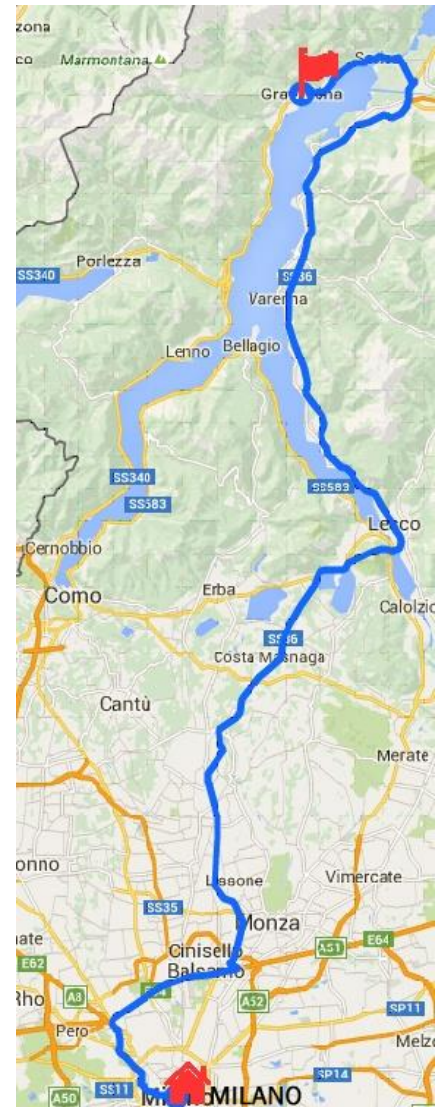
From North Lake Como take SS340dir (Strada Statale Regina) in Colico direction, and then from Colico the SS36 in Milan direction.
Duration: about 1h 40 minutes

PARKING:

The car park near “Gioia” stop (Metro Green Line 2) is the easiest solution for those who arrive from SS36 (last stretch called Viale Zara), because it’s outside the Congestion Charge Area (called “Area C”).

From “Gioia” stop take the Metro Green Line 2 (Gessate or Cologno Nord direction) and get off at “Centrale Fs”. Here take the Metro Yellow Line 3 (S. Donato direction) and get off at “Duomo” stop (€ 1.50).

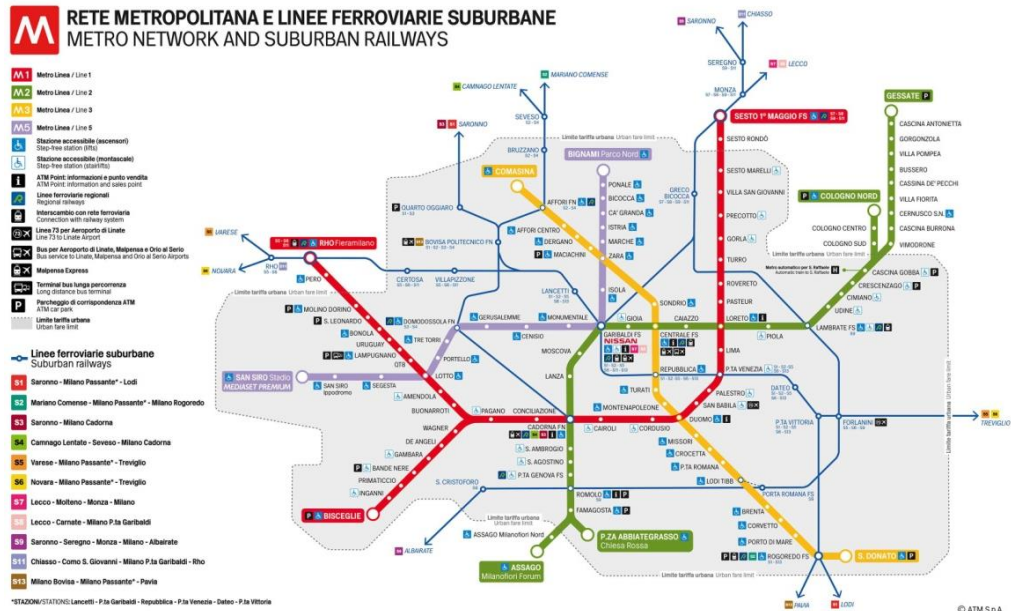


HOW TO MOVE AROUND MILAN

CASTELLO SFORZESCO Piazza Castello “Cairolì” Stop M1 Line	Castle: every day, 7am – 7.30pm (free entrance) Museums: from Tuesdays to Sundays: 9am – 5.30pm (Last entrance at 5pm) Museums ticket: - Adults: € 5.00 - Seniors (over 65), University students: € 3.00 - Free entry for children under 18 years old
SHOPPING	Corso Vittorio Emanuele, Piazza S. Babila (“Duomo” or “S. Babila” stops, M1 Line) Via Montenapoleone, Via della Spiga and fashion district (“Montenapoleone” stop, M3 Line)
